
Step 1: Visit lms.mcsilverta.org


Step 2: Access the Youth Peer Advocates group and training

- Select *Join group*



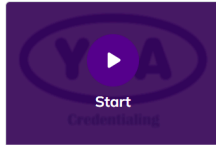
